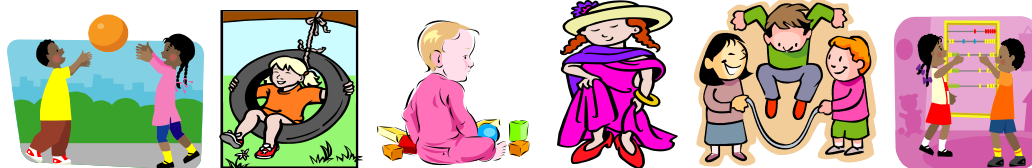


Baylis Court Nursery School Newsletter
